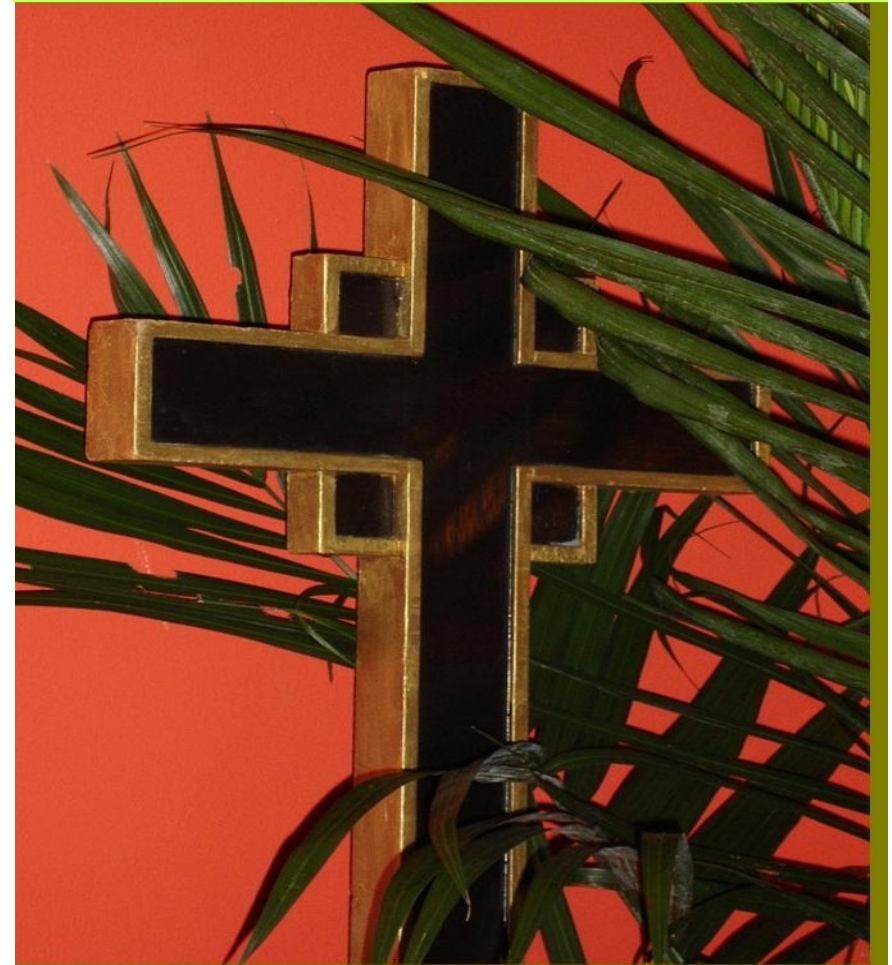

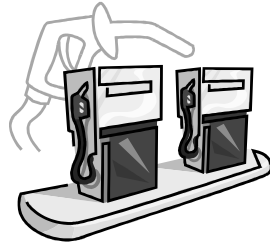

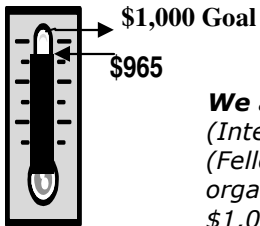
The car will leave NBCC at 5:30 PM

**WE ARE SAVED . . .**

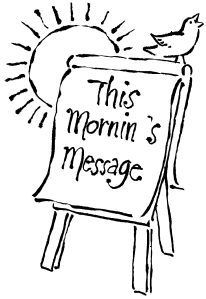
**By grace:** "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith-and

also-not the removal of dirt from the body but the pledge of a good  
conscience toward God. It saves you by the resurrection of Jesus  
Christ, who has gone into heaven and is at God's right hand with  
angels, authorities and powers in submission to him." 1 Peter 3:21-22
