What will it be like at the end of the world? The Bible describes it in terrifying and absolute language. In Matthew 24:37-41 Jesus uses some of the scariest and most sobering language in all the Bible: *“As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man. 38 For in the days before the flood, people were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, up to the day Noah entered the ark; 39 and they knew nothing about what would happen until the flood came and took them all away. That is how it will be at the coming of the Son of Man. 40 Two men will be in the field; one will be taken and the other left. 41 Two women will be grinding with a hand mill; one will be taken and the other left.”*

We don't know when the end of the world will happen, but we can make sure we're ready when it does. There are things we can do to make sure we are the one taken, and not the one left behind.

A couple of months ago Judy, Rebekah, and I went to the grand opening of Target Plaza at the Twins' new home, Target Field. We expected a lot of traffic near the new stadium, so our plan was to park in the place we always park for Twins games, by the Metrodome, and take the light rail over to the ballpark. We just missed the train when we got there, but saw by the schedule that another would be along in just 10 minutes. As we waited, a few other people showed up, and we all shared the warmth of the shelter.

When the train stopped in front of us there was a confused rush of people getting on and off. Judy and Rebekah started toward a door and got on the train, but I hesitated. A guy who had just exited the train was walking my way down the platform, and I stopped to let him pass. He was an older guy with long gray hair and a scraggly gray beard, pushing a bike with a guitar strapped into the basket. He was very kind, smiling as he said thank you when I let him pass.

But then the doors to the train closed, and I was still on the outside. There was a button that said "Push to open doors", and I was frantically pushing, but they didn't. And the next thing I know, Judy and Rebekah are on the way to the ballpark, and I've been left behind.

I had the comfort of knowing another train would be coming in 10 minutes, and that I'd meet Judy and Rebekah at our destination, but I don't know if I can describe the feeling and sensation of being left behind, and knowing that once the doors have closed the train is gone, and there's nothing you can do about it.

When I told this story in church, a young lady approached me afterwards and said I should have a T-shirt made that said, "Push the hippie out of the way and get on the train." That made me wonder about the things that might be standing in the way of my getting on the train. What in my life am I going to have to push out of the way?

Is there anything in your life you need to push out of the way? When God sends the train, will you be taken, or will you be left behind?

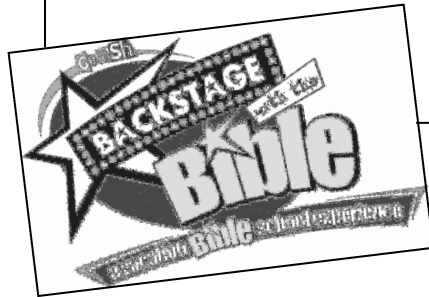
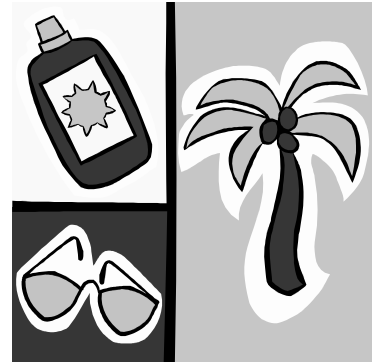
"Know Sweat" - NBCC Youth Trip to Cincinnati, Ohio - June 26-July 2

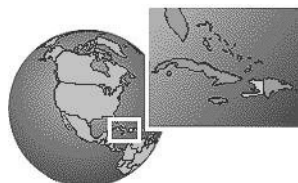
