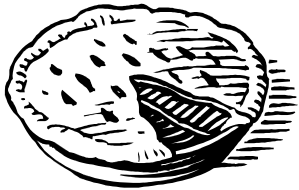

WE ARE SAVED . . .

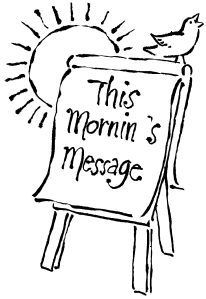
By grace: "For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith-and
