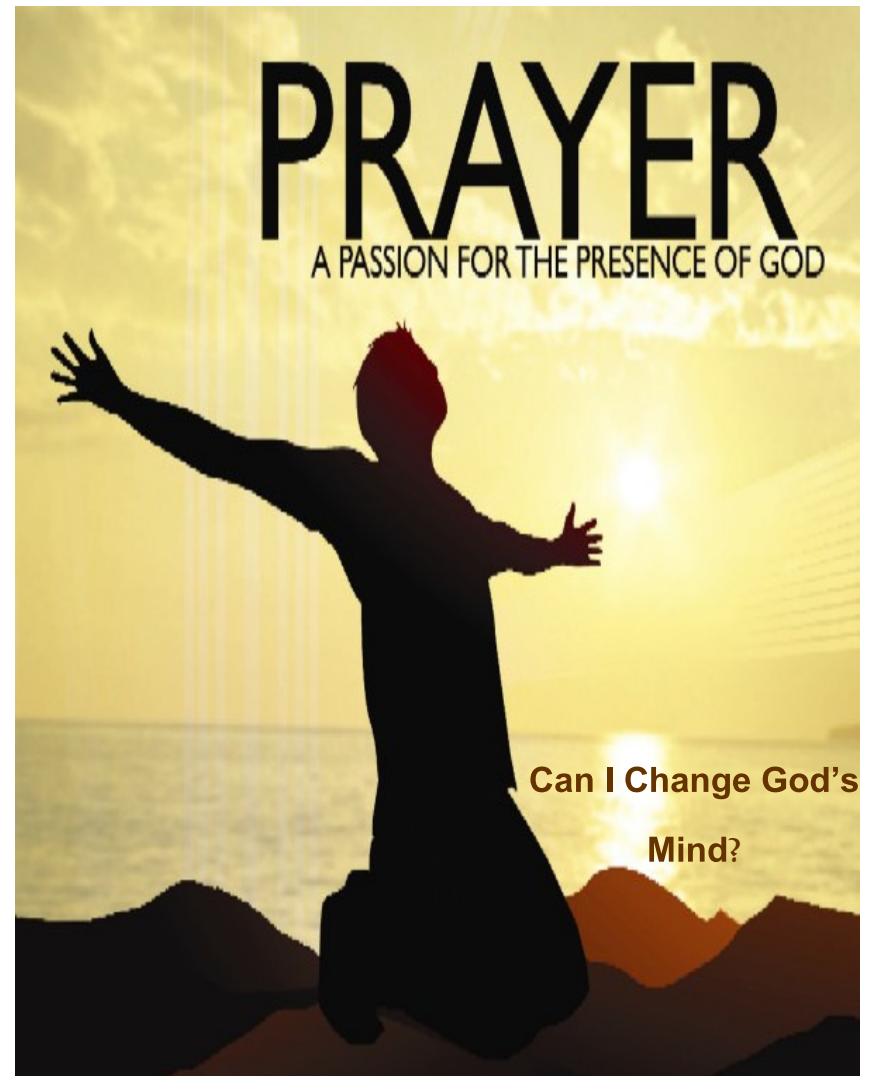

**Up north on Sunday morning? Worship here on Thursday evening!**

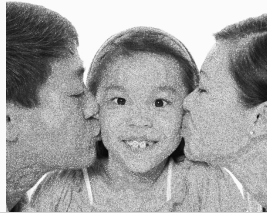
